The basis of the fuel surcharge will be the department of energy price index for the Midwest Region [www.eia.doe.gov](http://www.eia.doe.gov). The Fuel surcharge will be indexed monthly from a base of \$3.00/gal. On the first of each month the average of the previous week's fuel cost will be used to calculate the current month's fuel surcharge. When the monthly index falls below the base of \$3.00/gal, there will be no fuel surcharge for that month.
